Going for Goals

We will learn to manage frustration, set success criteria, maintain a positive mindset when facing challenges and learn the importance of perseverance even in the face of setbacks.

History

Stone Age to Iron Age

We'll compare these periods, learning about chronology, roles and key developments. We'll examine artefacts to uncover what they reveal about life in the past. We'll also investigate daily life and how it evolved through the Stone, Bronze, and Iron Ages.

DT

Nutrition

We will explore taste and texture by sampling different soups and will identify the role of herbs and other ingredients. We will then practice safe food preparation techniques, including chopping, grating, slicing, and peeling vegetables to make our own.

English

We will be reading *The Iron Man* and focusing on character descriptions and a "defeating the monster" tale. Our reading activities will explore themes like the triumph of good over evil, using inferences and predictions to understand characters' feelings and actions. In writing, we'll create descriptive narratives, developing characters and plots with vivid vocabulary, similes, and expanded noun phrases.

Maths

We will be learning the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. We will also focus on identifying and understanding right angles, as well as exploring and manipulating additive relationships. We will also work on securing efficient mental calculation strategies to build confidence and fluency in solving problems.

PE

We are focusing on Outdoor and Adventurous Activities, which will help us develop teamwork and problem-solving skills. We will participate in challenges such as orienteering, navigation, and group tasks that require cooperation and communication.

Galilee to Jerusalem
