Relationships

We will be looking at taking responsibility for our own behaviour as well as strategies to modify inappropriate behaviour. This topic will also include remembering people even if we don't see them and how to respond safely to adults we do not know.

English

We will be reading the text 'Farther'. We will be working on features of instruction texts and using rhetorical questions, commas in a list as well as 'bossy verbs'. We will also be working hard on spelling words from the Year 3 / 4 word list and developing our cursive handwriting skills.

Maths

There will be a large focus on fractions and decimals, including improper and equivalent fractions. We will also look at adding and subtracting fractions. Decimal work will include dividing 2-digits by ten and a hundred to learn knowledge of tenths and hundredths.

PE

Multi-skills

This will be delivered by an LSSP coach and will cover all of the skills needed to play many sports such as football, basketball, tennis and badminton.

Geography

Canals

We will learn to understand how and why canals were built and how they are different to rivers. We will learn how canals were used in the past and how they are used today and how the Industrial Revolution changed the landscape of Britain.

Programming

We will develop our coding skills by learning to code and control sphero devices.

We will be evaluating different types of pizza, looking at designing and making our own, looking into the nutritional values of the ingredients. There will also be a focus on health and safety and hygiene in and around the kitchen and cooking areas.
