

## Get Set for Life

### Going for Goals

We will identify goals to help us become more effective learners, ways to keep positive and manage feelings, and take responsibility for our own progress.

## English

We will be reading the novel, 'Running Wild' by Michael Morpurgo and extracts of 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell. Through these books, we will use Talk for Writing to write journey tales which include a flashback and will deepen our understanding of other areas of grammar and related terminology.

## Maths

We will be exploring fractions, decimals and percentages as well as algebra. We will also explore measure and geometry by reading, writing and converting between standard units of measure, calculating area and perimeter of shapes as well as exploring 2 and 3D shapes.

## PE

### Gymnastics

We will learn how to do different types of gymnastics rolls, balances, jumps and handstands and cartwheels. We will then develop combining these into sequences.

## History

### Maya civilisation

We will learn about the chronology of this time period, use sources to make predictions and inferences and learn about daily life. We will also receive a visit from archaeologist Dr Diane.

## Art

### Collage

We will be exploring the work of Hannah Hoch who was famous for her use of collage. We will experiment with different medium and texture to create different moods.
