The Little Red Hen

We will be reading the book: 'The Little Red Hen' and will learn to tell the story, sequence it, answer questions and learn lots of new vocabulary. We will join in with repeated refrains and will fill in rhyming words.

We will listen to and begin to talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding and will discuss characters, events and settings. In Read Write Inc phonics, we will begin to learn set 1 sounds and will begin to orally blend using 'Fred Talk.'

Understanding the world

Autumn

We will talk about members of our family in this country as well as those in other parts of the world and will name and describe people who are familiar to us.

We will begin to look at our senses and will carry out fun activities to explore our senses. We will also talk about how we have changed from when we were babies in the past to now.

RE

Creation and Covenant

We will focus on our own feelings and experiences of being known by name.

We will recognise some phrases which tell about God's love for us and will talk about our own experiences and feelings of being welcomed.

We will also begin to wonder about how we can make others feel welcome. We will then begin to recognise and use some religious sign and symbols used in baptism.

Maths

Number

We will begin by subitising within 3. We will then focus on counting skills and will explore how all numbers are made of 1s before moving on to the composition of 3 and 4. We will then compare sets by using the language of comparison: more than and fewer than.

Numerical patterns

We will create shape picture and consolidate 2D shape names. We will also begin to compare length, weight and capacity.

We will also continue, copy and create repeating patterns.
