The Gingerbread Man

We will be reading the book: 'The Gingerbread Man' and will learn to tell the story, sequence it, answer questions and learn lots of new vocabulary. We will write simple captions about the story and then will orally retell our own stories. We will also follow a recipe to make our own gingerbread men.

In Read Write Inc phonics, we will review Set 1 sounds including 'special friends' and will apply them when writing simple sentences. them in our writing using 'Fred fingers'.

Desert to Garden

We will focus on Lent and Holy week and begin by listening to the story of Jesus being tempted in the desert. This will lead us onto what Lent is and how during Lent we can grow as a person by helping others in many ways. We will also listen to other stories such as The Ten commandments, Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. From this we will find out about Easter being a celebration that shows us Jesus is with us still and how during Easter we celebrate new life.

Maths

Number

We will practice counting forwards and backwards to 30 and begin to order numbers between 1 and 10, noticing the '5 and a bit' structure.

We will use sentence stems to help us to explain how to order quantities to 10. We will then reason about which numbers are 'more than' others. practise identifying when 2 sets are equal in number. From this we will identify when a double is shown and explain why it is a double and we will investigate patterns of doubles.

Numerical patterns

We will continue to compare length, height, weight and capacity and will order 2-3 items by capacity and height. We will also begin to order and sequence familiar events

Spring

We will look at the season spring and discover differences and changes over time.
