

## Get Set for Life

### Relationships

We will explore relationships, including making judgements about guilt and learning about healthy relationships through *Journey in Love*. We will also take part in learning about mental health and restorative practice, the NSPCC PANTS rule, Mental Health Awareness Week and Refugee Week, developing understanding, empathy and respect for others.

## English

We will be reading *Hansel & Gretel*: a classic fairy tale full of tension and adventure. Using this story as inspiration, we will explore “beat the monster” narratives where characters must overcome danger and outsmart a villain. We will develop our characterisation skills, focusing on describing emotions, actions and relationships to bring stories to life.

## Maths

We will be learning about unit fractions, developing our understanding of what fractions are and how they represent equal parts of a whole. We will explore how to recognise, compare and use unit fractions in different contexts. Throughout the half term, we will build our reasoning skills and apply our knowledge to solve problems involving fractions in practical and visual ways.

## PE

### Athletics

We will explore athletics, developing skills in running, jumping and throwing. We will learn how to improve speed, distance and technique across a range of events. We will also build stamina, coordination and control, while applying their skills in competitive and personal challenge activities.

## History

### Royal Albert Dock

We will examine how the docks have changed over time, from their industrial beginnings to their role in modern trade and transport. Through maps, photographs, and historical accounts, we will learn about the people who worked in the docks and how innovations in shipping and infrastructure shaped the local area.

# YEAR 3 – SUMMER 1

## Computing

### Programming

We will design and build our own interactive stories or games in Scratch, developing key coding concepts such as sequences, loops, and variables.

## Spanish

### Leisure

We will explore the topic of leisure, learning vocabulary for different sports and activities. We will practise giving opinions, such as likes and dislikes, and use numbers to 39 in speaking and writing tasks. Through games and conversations, we will build confidence in using simple phrases and responding in Spanish.

## RE

### To the Ends of the Earth

We will explore key stories from the period after Jesus’ resurrection, focusing on how the disciples were transformed and sent out to share the Good News. We will reflect on what it means to be a modern-day disciple, and how we are called to share love, hope, and faith in our own communities.

## Science

### Forces and Magnets

We will investigate how different objects move on various surfaces and explore the effects of pushes and pulls. We will carry out hands-on investigations to test the strength of magnets and learn how magnetic poles attract and repel. We will also look at how magnets are used in everyday life and in technology.

## Art

### Banksy

We will explore how street art can communicate powerful messages. We will analyse his use of symbolism, humour, and political themes before creating our own sculptures inspired by his work.

## Music

### Disco

We will explore *Bringing Us Together*, focusing on the style of disco. We will develop our singing and performance skills, learning about rhythm, pulse and groove. We will also explore how music can bring people together, building confidence through group singing, listening and performing activities.
