

Get Set for Life

Changes

We will explore how changes can affect feelings and emotions, especially when they are unexpected or unwanted. We will learn why change can sometimes feel uncomfortable or frightening and develop empathy by understanding how others may behave when they are finding change difficult.

English

We will use the model text *Slay Smok the Dragon!* to explore persuasive writing. We will learn the features of persuasion before creating our own fantasy-based persuasive pieces using ambitious vocabulary, rhetorical questions and powerful arguments to engage the reader.

Maths

We pupils will develop our understanding of shape, time and money. We will identify and compare different shapes, practise telling the time using both analogue and digital clocks, and apply money skills through real-life problem-solving activities.

PE

OAA

Our focus will be Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA), where we will develop teamwork, communication and problem-solving skills through a range of practical challenges and activities.

Geography

Fieldwork

We will take part in local area fieldwork, comparing our school and surrounding area with a school in Crosby. We will use maps, observations and data collection skills to investigate similarities and differences between the two locations.

Computing

We will develop our media skills using iMovie. We will learn the basic controls of the program, including how to import pre-recorded videos, play back footage and edit or delete clips to improve our final project.

The Water Cycle

We will learn about the water cycle, exploring evaporation, condensation and precipitation, and understanding how water moves through the environment in a continuous cycle.

Van Gogh

We will explore the work of Vincent van Gogh and use collage techniques to create our own artwork inspired by his use of colour, texture and movement. We will experiment with different materials and develop our creativity through layered designs.
